Kā Pūtea Scholarships open on Tuesday 1st of March 2016 and close 5.00pm Friday 29th of April 2016

General and Targeted Scholarship selection will be made by end of May 2016 and successful applicants will be awarded their scholarship monies in June 2016. All applicants not awarded a targeted or general scholarship will then have their applications forwarded to their Papatipu Rūnanga for assessment. Papatipu scholarships will be selected and awarded at the discretion of each Rūnanga between June and November.

Kā Pūtea Grants open on Tuesday 1st of March 2016 and close Monday 5th December 2016

Completed and approved grants will be paid around the 15th and 30th of each month. Please allow 15 working days for processing. If your application is incomplete the process will be delayed.

Grants Value

\$250 for 1st year of full-time tertiary study
\$500 for 2nd or subsequent year(s) of full-time tertiary study.
Pro-rata grant payments will apply for part-time applicants: \$125 for the first year of application and \$250 for 2nd and subsequent years of application.
