## Nohoanga Site Information Sheet

# HAPUKU RIVER, KAIKŌURA



#### **Getting there**

- The site is on the beach front, at the northern end of Hapuku Road (number 15), Kaikōura.
- From the north follow Hapuku Road (on the south side of Hapuku River) off SHW1 all the way to the end. The site is in the paddock at the end of the road.
- From the south from Kaikōura township, turn right at the fork of SHW1 (Athelney Road / Beach Road) and Hapuku Road, Crazy Janes Hairdressers and the Top Shop Dairy are on this corner. Follow Hapuku Road all the way to the end. The site is in the paddock on the right (beach side) at the end.
- The site is not signposted or marked.

#### **Physical description**

- The nohoanga is in a large, relatively flat paddock.
- Minimal shelter, plenty of sun but site is exposed to sea breeze.
- Limited privacy as residential houses are located opposite the site.

#### Vehicle access and parking

- Vehicle access is via paved roads to the site.
- Suitable for campervans and caravans.



### **Facilities and services**

- The are no facilities at the Hapuku River nohoanga site. Site users will need to provide their own toilet (portaloo or chemical toilet) and shower facilities.
- Nohoanga site users are required to provide their own water supplies.
- There is good cell phone reception at this site.
- All rubbish and waste must be removed on departure. See key contacts below for details
  of refuse and dumping stations.



#### **Hazards**

- This site is often grazed by stock. Stock will be either removed or moved to the southern end of the paddock when whānui want to use the site. The whole paddock has an electric fence lining the fencing. Its important users book at least 5 days in advance as to give time for stock to be moved, and for the electric fence covering the entrance gate to be turned off and moved so users can enter.
