NOHOANGA SITE INFORMATION SHEET

LAKE HAWEA - NOHOANGA 3 (ADJ CAMPGROUND)



Getting there

- The site is just outside of the Hawea Township, across the bridge.
- It is located next to the Lake Hawea Holiday Park (The Camp) at SH6, 1208 Lake Hawea Makarora Road.
- From the highway, turn into the campground entrance, then turn right and drive along the road located between the boat ramp and the public toilets. The track up onto the site is at the end of this road.
- The nohoanga site is on top of the hill behind the toilet block.

Physical description

- The nohoanga is on an embankment overlooking Lake Hawea, next to the Lake Hawea camping ground, which is extremely popular particularly during the summer months.
- The site is large, flat, and well sheltered.

Vehicle access and parking

- Vehicle access onto the nohoanga site is good, although there is a slight climb onto the site, which may prove difficult for large caravans or campervans.
- The road to the right may be more suitable for campervans. Care should be taken when using this road as there are no barriers between the road and banks which border the lake.
- There is plenty of parking on site.



Facilities and services

- Nohoanga site users are required to provide their own water supplies.
- The are no facilities on the Lake Hawea (Adj Campground) nohoanga site. Site users will need to provide their own toilet (portaloo or chemical toilet) and shower facilities.
- A public toilet block is located next to the nohoanga site. Nohoanga users are permitted to
 use these facilities. The block is often maintained and cleaned by QLDC. Nohoanga users
 need to help keep the block clean and bring their own toilet paper.
- Nohoanga site users are permitted to use the adjacent facilities at The Camp with prior permission from the Camp Manager and payment of the standard fees (casual fee per person per day – subject to change). Email Nikkie and Julie at stay@thecamp.co.nz to check if use of the facilities is available.
- Facilities at the Camp are not available for nohoanga site users over the Christmas and New Year period due to high use. Nohoanga users will need to provide their own toilet, shower and make water arrangements during the period of 23 December to 10 January.
- Please be respectful of other nohoanga users use and their enjoyment. Don't throw a
 party, play loud music after 10pm or make excessive noise that could affect their
 experience.
- A dump station is also available to empty caravan or campervan toilets at a cost. If you are
 using these facilities, you will need to seek prior permission from The Camp Manager.
- The Camp has a shop and bike hire which are available to nohoanga users.
- A food truck is also located at The Camp which sells burgers and tacos.
- Take extra care when disposing of grey water. This should not be disposed of into the lake.
- A boat ramp is located adjacent to nohoanga site. Daily use fee is \$5. Annual charge is \$50.
- There is limited cell phone reception on this site.
- All rubbish and waste must be removed on departure. See key contacts below for details of refuse and dumping stations.





Hazards

- Some rivers, lakes or waterways may have health warnings applied to them throughout the
 year for toxic algae and bacteria such as benthic cyanobacteria. Regional and District Councils
 will have up to date information on their websites regarding any waterway health warnings in
 place.

Site restrictions

- Subject to operating easement granted to Contact Energy.
- Dogs are not permitted.
- Fires are not permitted.
- Music and loud noise after 10pm is not permitted.
