# Hapuku River, Kaikōura



## **&** Getting there

- The site is on the beach front, at the northern end of Hapuku Road (number 15), Kaikōura. Entry is through a gate on the corner.
- From the north Exit SHW1 onto Lovers Lane or Factory Road. Follow until you reach Hapuku Road (on the south side of Hapuku River). The nohoanga is sited in a paddock at the corner of Lovers Lane and Hapuku Road.

From the south - from Kaikoura township, turn right at the fork of SHW1/Athelney Road onto Old

• Beach Road. Crazy Janes Hairdressers and the Top Shop Dairy are on this corner. Turn right from Old Beach Road and follow to the end. Turn left onto Hapuku Road. Follow Hapuku Road all the way to the end. The site is in the paddock on the right (beach side) at the end.

## Physical appearance

- The nohoanga is in a large, relatively flat paddock. The pine trees have recently been removed. The
- nohoanga is fenced around the boundary.
- There is minimal shelter but plenty of sun. The site is also exposed to the sea breeze.
- There is limited privacy as residential houses are located opposite the site and the general public uses Lovers Lane to access the beach.

#### Vehicle access and parking

Vehicle access is via sealed roads to the site.

- · Suitable for campervans and caravans but there are some dips and rocks to be aware
- of in the centre.



### O Facilities and services

- The are no facilities at the Hapuku River nohoanga site. Site users will need to provide their own toilet (portaloo or chemical toilet) and shower facilities.
- Nohoanga site users are required to provide their own water supplies.
- There is good cell phone reception at this site.
- All rubbish and waste must be removed on departure. See key contacts below for details of refuse and dumping stations.

- Barbed wire along some of the fences.
