This is a wonderful opportunity for rangatahi to have a paid placement in one of our world class tourism businesses.

Purpose

Our aspiration is to ignite a passion for more Ngāi Tahu tertiary students to reach their potential in specific areas across the Ngāi Tahu Tourism Group and create a pipeline of aspiring recruits. In addition, we will enable rangatahi interns to strengthen their Ngāi Tahutanga and whakapapa connections.

The Summer Internship Programme will provide aspiring Ngāi Tahu rangatahi with a tailored experience at one of Ngāi Tahu Tourism's iconic tourism businesses with the opportunity to move into a permanent role in the future or receive guidance and support into further tertiary options.

The programme offers customised internship experiences for each tourism business unit.

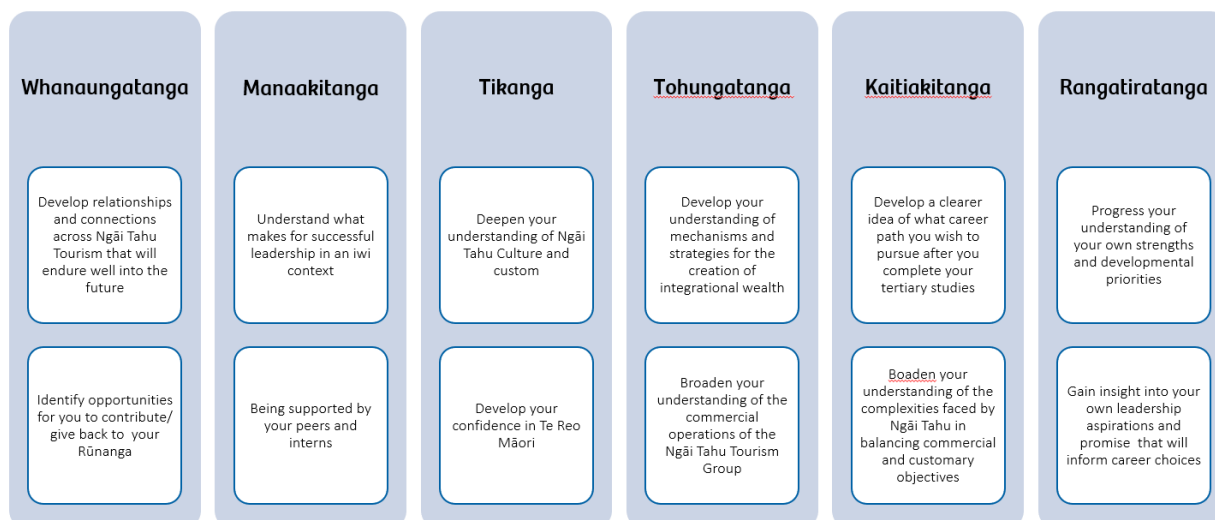
Key Objectives

The key objectives of the internships are to:

- provide interns with knowledge of a Ngāi Tahu Tourism business
- provide opportunities to help develop strong networks within Ngāi Tahu whānau, Ngāi Tahu leadership and their own Papatipu Rūnanga
- increase interns knowledge of and passion for Ngāi Tahu culture
- provide valuable work experience and an environment where interns can:
apply theory to real-life work situations
- enhance work-ready skills, to ensure they can communicate and adapt to meet the requirements of a real business
- contribute to Ngāi Tahu Tourism's purpose to make the connection with their customers, through their people, to their place and to Ngāi Tahu
- earn some money over the summer break

Key Criteria

To be eligible for an internship you will need:

- to be registered as Ngāi Tahu, have a passion to work for your iwi, show energy and commitment and genuinely have a desire to learn and succeed
- at least one year of completed tertiary study for a diploma/degree in any discipline
- to be a full-time/part-time student at a New Zealand tertiary institution (or have completed your diploma/degree in the last twelve months)
- to be a New Zealand citizen, permanent resident or hold a valid visa that contains conditions for work

You cannot apply for an internship if you are studying outside of New Zealand.

Sole discretion to accept or decline an application, rests with the selection team. Decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Conditions

Internships will be offered at the discretion of each individual business unit each year, depending on requirements and resources. All internships will be advertised, and we will assess all applications as they arrive. Each internship will take place in the tertiary summer break, usually between November and February.

The internship will consist of:

- valuable experience across a range of operational and business areas
- paid employment and accommodation
- mentoring from experienced Ngāi Tahu Tourism kaimahi
- cultural development
- future Ngāi Tahu Tourism opportunities
